

Book Anatomy Checklist

Dear Author,

The following checklist is a guideline, not a rule. For the most part, you can pick and choose whichever pieces you want to include and you can even reorder them to another location if you'd prefer.

This checklist contains items used in fiction and nonfiction books, noted with either an F for fiction, NF for nonfiction, or F/NF for both in front of each item. Some of these may be used primarily in one or the other, but most often, these can be used in either genre.

I have also noted the industry standard as to which page each item should begin on. When you crack open a book, the right page is known as **recto** and should have an odd page number, while the left page is known as **verso** and should have an even page number.
